

Empordà Heritage: Two Historic Houses that defy time.

Ascending to the first floor, we encounter a central room dominated by a large dining table and a balcony that opens to the main façade. This floor accommodates two cozy bedrooms and a full bathroom. The rustic kitchen, with its traditional fireplace, invites to prepare delicious meals, while a private living room, also with a fireplace, offers an intimate corner for relaxation. A 32m² covered

terrace presents itself as the perfect spot to enjoy the views and the Mediterranean climate.

The second floor surprises with an open and airy space, ideal for adapting it to the needs of each owner. It also features two separate rooms and two suites, each with its own bathroom and fireplace, providing exceptional luxury and comfort.

The secondary house, although more modest in size with its 180 square meters, is not lacking in charm. On the ground floor, an entrance hall welcomes us next to an old stable with a drinking trough, reminding us of its rural past. The first floor houses a cozy dining room, a functional kitchen, and a living room with a fireplace. On the second floor, we find two bedrooms and a bathroom with a bathtub. Crowning the house is a loft that offers a terrace with panoramic views of Empordà and a small but practical laundry room.

The complex is completed by a spacious garden that connects both houses, where a heated pool invites relaxation and enjoyment. The property has been carefully renovated since 2003, preserving original elements such as vaults and arches, and incorporating artisan stained glass that adds a unique touch to each room. The house has air conditioning and gas heating. Both the boiler and the air conditioning units have been recently installed.

Strategically located just 16 kilometers from the sea, 29 from Girona, 65 from the French border, and 125 from Barcelona, this property represents an exceptional real estate opportunity. It is more than just a purchase; it is acquiring a historical heritage, a living space that combines Catalan architectural tradition with the comforts of the 21st century.
